

I urge Northern California to support Proposition 3 on the Nov. 6 ballot. As I look to the future, we need significant investment in our regional water infrastructure – to support the environment, farms and people. More specifically, we need to make investments in sustainable groundwater, better habitat for salmon and birds, and safe drinking water for all Californians.

Proposition 3 also provides needed funds for flood control, strengthening levees, and repairs at Oroville Dam.
